Editorial....

General Secretary's Report for the year 2016-17

Dear Comrades,

At the outset, I on behalf of our SBI Pensioners' Circle Association, thank all our esteemed members for enthusiastically and actively participating in our joint efforts for achievement in our long pending demands/issues concerning our members. It was only due to the whole hearted contributions of all the members of our circle, our esteemed Federation was able to achieve long pending demands.

1. First of all I had the honour to lead my team of our Circle office-bearers, for arranging our 33rd Annual General Meeting which was held in November, 2016. It was a great success and the same were attended by approx. 300 members from whole the circle viz. Pb.-I and Pb.-II, Haryana, H.P. and J&K modules. This meeting was chaired by our respected General Manager Network-2 Sh. Sanjay Kumar at L.H.O. S/Sh. A. Bhattacharya, G.M. Network-III and G.B. Singh, Dy. General Manager and Circle Development Officer, the office-bearers of all the three working associations i.e. SBI Officers' Association, SBI Staff Association and SBI S/C, S/T Welfare Association participated. Our all those guests were honoured with a presentation of shawl each. I am really thankful to the above guests, who spared some time from their families since the meeting was held on Sunday. All the Guests spoke in their own style and appreciated the good work done by our association. Sh. H.S. Batra, President of the SBI Staff Association presented two gifts as a token of respect to their old colleagues/senior members, present thereat in the meeting. The office-bearers of the Circle Associations

led by S/Sh. O.P. Banga, V.K. Kalia, Y.P. Suri, U.S. Negi and Ujjagar Singh, all Vice-Presidents of our modules viz. Pb.-I, Pb.-II, Haryana, H.P. and J&K, alongwith our organising and zonal secretaries also attended the meeting. The meeting was chaired by our Circle President Sh. A.C. Rambani, who also spoke few words during his speech. Myself also spoke few words by thanking all the guests/dignitaries for having come to attend our this A.G.M.

In the second session, after the interval which is called as business session, I read the report of 2015-16 and the accounts of the Association were presented which were passed by voice vote and it was for the first time that no query was raised by any of the member present thereat in the meeting as I had already explained all the developments of the circle association and the Federation of SBI Pensioners' Association. 25 members of 75 years and above, were also honoured with the presentation of Shawl each.

2. The Circle management was very kind enough to involve our Association in the Bank's all the functions starting from 26.01.2017 Bank's Day, 15th August celebrations, cultural night hosted by the Bank, the structured meeting with our office-bearers etc. On 26.01.2017, the oldest member of our Association in Tricity Sh. H.R. Harjai, who is 89 years old, our respected Chief General Manager Sh. Nand Kishora ji honoured him by presenting a Shawl as a token of respect from the Bank.

3. I and my entire team i.e. all the principal office bearers of the circle association, were instrumental in enrolling more than 300 new members with our Association for which I am grateful to them for working as a team.

4. Throughout all the year, many talks were held on our Wednesday's meetings by the reputed doctors on various subjects mostly from Fortis Hospital, Max Hospital, Ivy Hospital and other doctors few of them delivered their medical talks with the involvement of our Bank's Doctor, Dr. Satbir Singh. The members took full advantage of the occasion's and discussed their medical problems and got consultations with them also. Three medical health check-up camps were also held by Bank's Doctor, Max Hospital, Ivy Hospital etc., which again was fully utilised by our pensioner colleagues.

5. Six of our office-bearers from the Circle Association namely Sh. T.R. Gupta, General Secretary; Sh. S.K. Sharma, Treasurer; Sh. Tek Chand, Assistant Treasurer; Sh. K.P. Joshi, Executive Committee member; Sh. V.K. Kalia, Vice President of Pb-II module and Sh. U.S. Negi, our Vice President of H.P. Module, participated in the Federation's Annual General Meeting at Chennai on 29th and 30th March, 2017, which was a grand success.

Pensioners' meets were also held at Shimla, Jalandhar, Pathankot, Jammu and Kurukshetra, where all the senior pensioners were honoured by the circle association. I am thankful to all the comrades who were associated in the above meetings which were grand success.

6. In the year 2017, we also started attending the retirement meetings of the bank's employee, called by the Bank at our Learning Centre at Panchkula. Our sincere thanks to respected C.D.O. Sh. D.B. Singh, AGM; Sh. Sharma (who was promoted to the Dy. Gen. Manager

rank); Sh. R. Budwar, AGM PPG and Mrs. Kamlesh Sekhon, AGM HR (now promoted as Dy. General Manager) and Sh. J.S. Mohi, AGM OAD, who provided this platform for our Association for interaction with the going to be retired employees at the Staff Learning Centre, Panchkula. Our sincere thanks to Sh. P.K. Lath, Asstt. General Manager, Staff Learning Centre, Panchkula for all the cooperation in this regard.

7. Dear comrades, in the year 2017, our Federation took keen interest and pains for the welfare of our members. First, a subsidy of Rs.6000/- was arranged from the Corporate Office for which we are thankful to our working associations also, who were there to support our this cause because the premiums of the mediclaim insurance were hiked by 3 times. The biggest achievement and most cherished demand of 5th to 7th B.P.S. employees were got cleared from the Govt. of India as well as from the Corporate Centre for which 90% Adhoc relief has been paid to about 90% members i.e. 1.11.87 to 31.10.2002. By the time, you get our this copy of Pensioners' Mail, I hope the exercise might be on the verge of closure with disbursement of 90% to all the affected members. This is a great victory. The arrears to 7th B.P.S. has been paid from the date of retirement. The 90% Adhoc is likely to be paid to 5th, 6th and family pensioners very shortly as requested by the President of the Federation of SBI Pensioners.

8. The Executive Committee and the Central Committee meetings were also held in March, 2017 and September, 2017, which were attended by the respective office-bearers for the Circle.

9. The New Year Day, Lohri Day and after the Govt. of India cleared our 5th to 7th B.P.S. were celebrated in our weekly meetings with distribution of some sweets.

10. The latest development in our Court Case for 50% payment at all the stages is as follows :

We have been advised by our General Secretary of Federation of SBI Associations, Sh. Ramesh Babu that our captioned case was slated for 13.09.2017. At about 3.50 p.m. on the date, federation's case was taken by Delhi High Court for hearing. Court enquired the Government regarding notification on amendment of regulations, but Counsel of Govt. of India requested for adjournment for which Court expressed inability to do so. The Hon'ble bench directed our Counsel for further presentation of Federation case. Our Counsel presented

the case effectively comparing revision of Pension from 5th to 9th B.P.S. an injustice faced by the retirees/pensioners based on a chart prepared by the Counsel, also made a reference to Supreme Court judgements and also referred to SBI recommendations to Govt. of India dated 30.10.2002. The Federation Counsels presentation has been concluded. Therefore, senior counsel for Govt. and Bank started presentation based on its counter affidavit. Both Counsels were asked to furnish particulars of pension funds as on date.

Matter adjourned for 25.09.2017 for further arguments. Now as per the above developments of 13.09.2017, shows a positive development in our case as our Bank is quite comfortable in position to pay the arrears to all the pensioners at 50% at all the levels of their scales. Hope for the best as the judgement is expected very soon, most likely in our favour. By the grace of God, this case, which is being fought for the last 6 to 7 years, is in the state of affairs where judgement is expected very soon.

11. For fighting the captioned case in the Delhi High Court, you know, huge funds were/are required by the Federation. In this connection, the Federation had requested to our Chandigarh Circle Unit to send Rs.100/- per head as a legal fund (with our strength of 2015 year, where we had 2800 members at that time), which becomes about 2,80,000/- (Rupees Two lacs Eighty thousands only). For the last one year, we have been able to collect approx. Rs. 2,40,000/- as a Legal Fund from all the Circle members. An amount of Rs.1,40,000/- has been sent to the Federation about 6 months back and remaining Rs.1,40,000/- is being sent shortly (totalling to Rs.2,80,000/-). But we are not going to make any further appeal for the same as we have reasonable funds to do the needful. I once again thank all the members of our Circle Association for contributing towards legal fund whole-heartedly, especially, our H.P. Module, which contributed 40% of our total collection.

12. On the payment of 90% Adhoc relief to the pensioners of 5th to 7th B.P.S., we had requested the members, who have or who is going to have quite a substantial amount as arrears/adhoc payment, to contribute Rs.1100/-, Rs.700/- and Rs.500/- slabs which is very meagre amount. In other circles, we have come to know that 3 to 5% amount has been asked by their respective associations. If you compare with them, we have only requested for contribution to roughly ½% of the Adhoc relief. I am glad to announce that once again

our members, who have got the payment of 90% Adhoc relief, have come forward to donate the requisite amount with a smiling face. I once again request our affected members to send their contributions to the office-bearers at Circle level against their corresponding addresses, who have not yet remitted the same.

13. In the last but not the least, I am very much thankful to our members who attends our weekly meetings at LHO Chandigarh in large numbers and keep utmost discipline and cooperation, mutual respect for each other, in general and all the members of the Circle in the particular. I receive so many good wishes on behalf of our Association at Chandigarh and I reciprocate the same to all the more than 4500 members of the Circle Associations and hope that whenever any call comes from Federation/Association, they will not lag behind as usual. The Circle Association which is running in a very smooth and effective manner, is only due to all the members.

14. I once again thank my members in general and office-bearers in the particular, namely S/Sh . O.P. Banga, V.K. Kalia, Y.P. Suri, U.S. Negi, Ujjagar Singh (all Vice-President of different modules), S.K. Sharma, Treasurer; Tek Chand, Asstt. Treasurer; M.S. Mongia, K.P. Joshi, H.K. Sharma and Sh. Suresh Kaushal, our Asstt. General Secretary and above all of this, Sh. A.C. Rambani, who is our President and guiding spirit. I thank the management of S.B.I. very much for their proactive approach which I hope would continue in the future also. I am also thankful to all those whose names are not mentioned just like our all organising secretaries, zonal secretaries and regional secretaries of the Circle for their active involvement. I am also thankful to those, who may not be our members but has direct or indirect role with the Association. My special thanks to Sh. S.S. Kumaria, our Sub-Editor, who is brain behind our all these shows. I on behalf of our Circle Association, thank him and wish him good health and long life so that he continues to help/guide in the time to come also.

15. During my tenure, if something has been done inadvertently wrong, which may have caused any discomfort to anybody, I beg pardon for those with folded hands.

I on behalf of SBI Pensioners' Association, Chandigarh Circle, wish you and your family members a very very happy and colourful Diwali.

News from the Units...**BATALA UNIT**

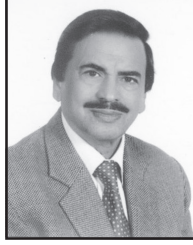
A meeting of Batala Unit was held on 24.08.2017 and the following office-bearers were elected unanimously :
